

HSE SERIOUS INCIDENT ALERT

Safety - Rear trailer in road train configuration dislodged from turntable

Incident date - $30^{th}/6/2015$

What happened?

- A sub-contractor was transporting sea containers being demobilised from site.
- After coupling and loading trailers the operator performed a tug test and traversed off site.
- Whilst travelling at a speed of approx 40Km/hr the rear trailer dislodged from the turntable.
- The trailers adjustable landing legs contacted the bitumen causing damage to the road.
- The incident occurred on Origin GPF Access Road.

Preliminary Findings

This incident is currently under investigation, however some of the preliminary findings are:

- The king pin beneath the trailer became dislodged from the turntable.
- The turntable cam track was subjected to build up of grime and debris.
- Operator did not check to confirm that the jaws had closed around the kingpin before driving.



Next steps/Key Reminders

- Investigation is currently underway results and key learning's will be shared when available.
- Coupling of a trailer behind any vehicle must be done in accordance with the manufacturers specifications.
- Turntable (Fifth Wheel) must be visually inspected to confirm that jaws are closed around the kingpin after performing the 'Tug Test' as per manufacturers specifications.
- Regular inspection and maintenance must be undertaken on turntable to ensure grime does not impact the capacity of the internal workings to effectively function.
- Review 'Loading and Unloading Checklist' to incorporate verification of positive visual inspection of locking jaws.

HSE Notice to be disseminated and communicated to Origin personnel and contractor partners. Notice to be placed on HSE noticeboards and shared at Toolbox Talks or Pre-Start meetings.
